Village Elections and Public Meetings

Pursuant to Executive Order 202.26, which was issued the evening of May 1, 2020, all village elections scheduled to take place in March, April, May, and June of 2020 have been postponed and rescheduled to September 15.

Village Mayor Adam Acquario, Trustee Lydia Davis, and Trustee Michael Lever submitted petitions containing enough signatures to qualify to be on the ballot and will remain in office until the election.

The Village of East Nassau will continue to hold in-person monthly meetings while maintaining appropriate social distancing. We will be utilizing technology to include trustees and appointed officials not present. Mayor Acquario makes appointments

A modified village organizational meeting was held on April 6, 2020. Acquario appointed Trustee Michael Lever as deputy mayor. Mike replaces trustee Lydia Davis. "Lydia did a great job as deputy and I respect her wishes to concentrate on the climate smart initiative," Acquario stated. In appointing Mike Lever, Acquario noted Mike's commitment to the village and said he was already doing many things that a deputy mayor does.

Also, Mayor Acquario appointed a new code enforcement officer, Joseph Tremblay, to replace the Paul Bullock, who stepped down.

Michael Dorr will remain public works superintendent, Jeanine McCarthy will remain treasurer, and Diane Maguire will remain clerk until the full organizational meeting, which will take place following the next election.

The East Nassau Building Department is dedicated to protecting the quality of life, health, safety and welfare of the residents of East Nassau through the enforcement of codes, ordinances and regulations.

The Building Department reviews construction plans and issues building permits for alterations, repairs, and new construction. They perform inspections, scheduled by the contractor or homeowner, as required by each permit. The building department also handles property maintenance complaints and enforces New York State Property Maintenance Codes.
