Village Elections: Tom Kernan re-elected Jeff Root wins board seat

Incumbent Tom Kernan wins another two- year term on the village board. Tom is working on a historical project for the village. Mayor Acquario reappointed Tom as village historian and Tom is working on cataloging all historical buildings within the village. His goal is to identify all historical homes/structures in the village and let the owners know the historical value they have.

Jeff Root comes to the village board from Hoags Corners. Jeff fills the seat formerly held by Susan Shapiro, who chose not to run for a full term. Susan filled a vacancy created when then Trustee Adam Acquario was elected mayor. We thank Susan for her service and look forward to working with Jeff, who brings a wealth of knowledge to the position.

Trustee Lydia Davis, Mike Lever, and Mayor Acquario are in the second year of their two-year terms. The next village election will be in March of 2020.

The East Nassau Building Department is dedicated to protecting the quality of life, health, safety and welfare of the residents of East Nassau through the enforcement of codes, ordinances and regulations.

The Building Department reviews construction plans and issues building permits for alterations, repairs, and new construction. They perform inspections, scheduled by the contractor or homeowner, as required by each permit. The building department also handles property maintenance complaints and enforces New York State Property Maintenance Codes.

Village adopts new land use regulations

After an exhaustive review that took over three years the village board finalized new land use regulations.

The board added new regulations for solar farms and cleaned up a lot of confusing language. Thanks to the assistance of former Mayor Mitch Levinn, who now acts as our webmaster, the document is on-line and contains links to definitions.
